- Grade 6/7 Camp Rough cost:
 - o \$250 each child for camp
 - Does not include cost of bus (roughly \$1200)
 - Cost for camping depends on where we go
 - ~40 students + teachers and parents
 - Could book a coach instead of school bus (need to look into it)
 - One time grant for affordability (Nadia will coordinate disbursement of funds confidentially)

 - o School District will not approve at elementary school anymore
 - o Trivia night at school, also used to sell alcohol but even that is very hard to get approval
