    is back now, but still no word. (update: they will add us to the next month's information
    again and see if they approve it then. We do not have to re-apply)
- TD Play donation update
  - Thought that pictures would be taken this week but we haven't heard back from them.
- Plant Fundraiser w/Confed Elem Order March 24th-April 14th, submitted by April 17<sup>th</sup>
  - Karen and Nancy to work on pricing/logistics/forms etc.
  - Confederation sells ½ flats and then sell during the pick up day or they plant them at the school.
  - Will need volunteers to pick up the plants at Confederation and bring them to Rosser.

- Hot Lunch
  - No Nutella or nut containing items will be sold.
  - Nicole will give Lynnessa her contacts.

- Lynnessa looked into School Cash Online as a platform for hot lunch but it seems expensive (\$200 to \$300 start-up fee) but can still use paper forms and cash payments.
